Post an invitation and a link or a URL on the ACPIVR website and/or twitter feed to recruit members to participate in online surveys.

Please complete the attached document electronically and enclose copies of the documentation requested. Once your application has been received it will be considered by the ACPIVR Research/PRO Officer and one other designated ACPIVR committee member and a decision conveyed to you as soon possible. This will normally be within a three week period. Please ensure that you leave adequate time for this review process when planning your research as the ACPIVR cannot guarantee to complete reviews within specific timescales.

Applicants must provide evidence of a 'favourable opinion' from the National Research Ethics Service or from a University Ethics Committee.
